- Strong policies reduce uncertainty.

The Modern Executive Challenge

- The problem is not information.

The Three Gates

- Before acting on any signal ask:
 - 1. Is it verified?
 - 2. Is it relevant?
 - 3. Is it urgent?
- Most confusion begins when these questions are skipped.

The Edge of Chaos

- Too much order creates rigidity.
